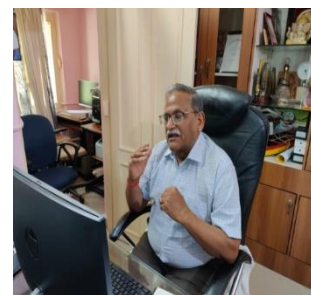
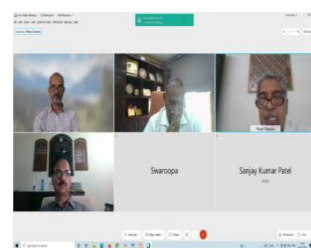
### Vice-Chancellor's Message

## Extension Activities:

### ➤ "Sukhet Model" for agri-waste management gains national attraction



Agri-wastes, crop residues and household wastes create sanitary problems, health hazards and emission of potential global warming gases due to uncontrolled and unattended disposal and burning. Cow dung is generally used for making cakes for cooking purpose in the resource poor villages. For addressing these issues, Sukhet Model was propounded by Dr. Ramesh Chandra Srivastava, Vice-Chancellor of Dr. RPCAU Pusa in which all biodegradable wastes are collected by deputed vendors and converted into vermicomposts. The farmers are, in return, provided LPG

cylinders of approximately same cost generally once in 2 months. This model gives an immense opportunity for rural employment and at least 10-12 youths can be employed in one such unit. During the corona menace, this model proved to be a boon to migrated labours. The model has gathered national attention and being replicated at several locations.

### ➤ Web-conference organized on World Environment Day at RPCAU, Pusa



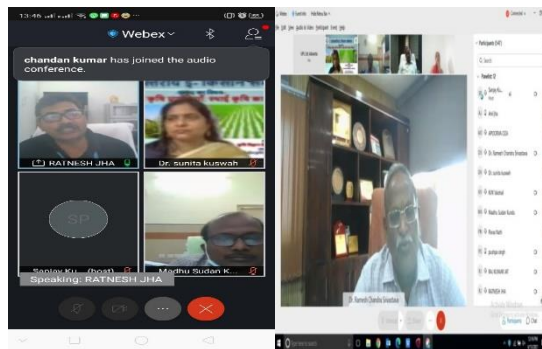

➤ **World Milk Day celebrated at KVKs:**



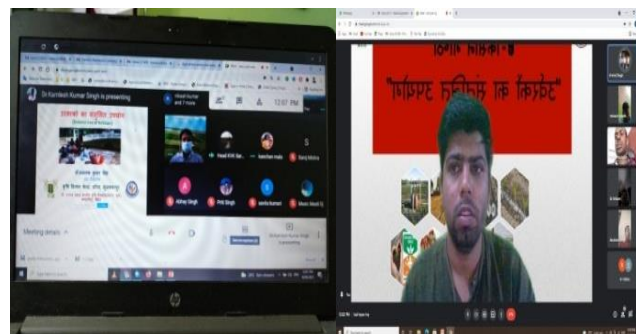

➤ **RPCAU starts Climate Smart Intervention in Patna District**

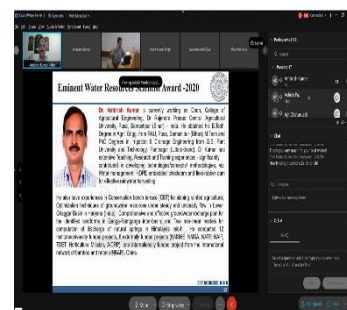
The team of scientists working under CSA Project visited 10 villages of Fatua and Daniawan blocks of Patna district and started climate smart interventions. Due to heavy downpour during past few days, the seedlings of rice were damaged and farmers were trying for some contingent measures. Such farmers were provided with short duration rice varieties for wet DSR, so that the crop could be harvested before first week of November to give space for timely sowing of wheat. They were also provided with ready to transplant seedlings as a measure to mitigate the losses due to seedling damage.

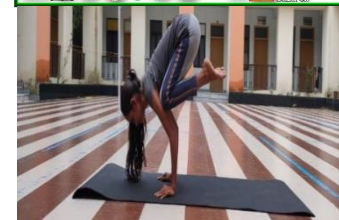


➤ **Dr S.P. Singh and team bagged the Best Oral Paper Presentation Award**

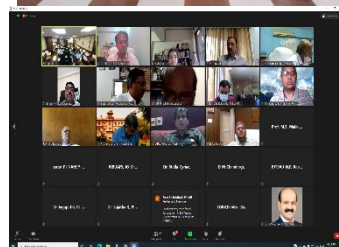
