



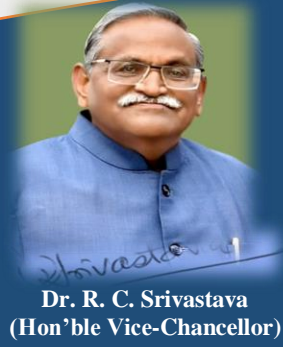
Vice-Chancellor's Message

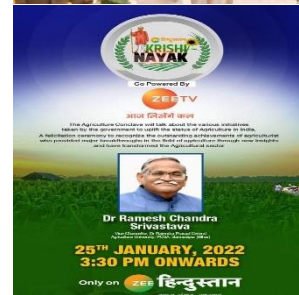

## Extension Activities

- **University Developed Turmeric Harvester Field Trial** - In the University funded project entitled as 'Mechanization of Turmeric crop through development of sowing and harvesting implement' which is running in the Department of Farm Machinery and Power Engineering of the College of Agricultural Engineering, a turmeric harvester has been developed. Field trial of the implement was conducted in farm of KVK Birauli in presence of the Dean, CAE along with the Project Coordinator and other scientific staffs of KVK, Birauli. The field performance was notably good with negligible amount of damage, missing, and left-over turmeric tuber in the field.
- **High Performing Varieties of Sugarcane developed by RPCAU Promoted to Advanced Varietal Trial at National level.** A meeting of sugarcane Breeders and Plant protection scientists of North-central and North-eastern, North-west and East coast zone was held virtually on 24<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. Dr. T.R. Sharma, DDG, ICAR was the chief guest and Dr. R.K. Singh, ADG chaired the meeting. Dr. A.D. Pathak, Project Coordinator and Director, IISR, Lucknow, Dr. G. Hem Prabha, Principal Investigator, Crop Improvement and Director, SBI, Coimbatore were present in the meeting. Based on the performance of the initial varietal trial, all the three varieties of sugarcane CoP 18436, CoP 18437 and CoP 18438 developed by SRI, RPCAU, Pusa were promoted for advanced varietal trials under the ICAR – All India Coordinated Research Project.
- **Preparation of Banana Powder-** The commercial banana powder preparation technique from mature unripe banana is being standardized by Department of Horticulture, TCA Dholi. Banana genotypes from experimental field of the ICAR-AICRP on Fruit are being evaluated for powder preparation. Presently, four different banana genotypes, viz., 'Malbhog' (AAB), 'Grand Naine' (AAA), 'Alpan' (AAB) and 'BBy Batesha (ABB)' are successfully dehydrated as banana powder. The nutritional profiling and biochemical analysis of these genotypes are in progress.
- **Director of Research visited the experimental trials of maize and potato** - Director Research, RPCAU, Pusa along with Dean TCA, Dholi visited maize and potato fields of Dholi campus on 28<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 to monitor the ongoing AICRP programmes. During the visit scientists associated with the respective ICAR-AICRPs were also present.

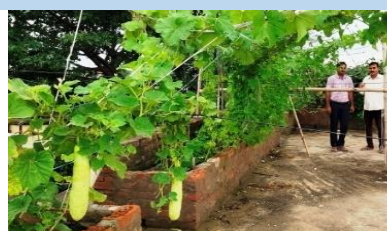


## Extension Activities
