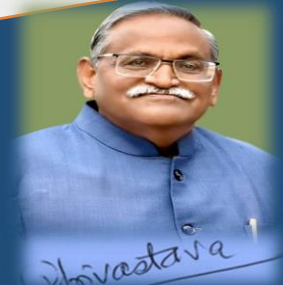

Two days Orientation workshop on "Experiential learning for Agri-preneurship" was organized by the Directorate of planning, RPCAU, Pusa during 27-28 June 2022 at Vidyapati Sabhagar under the chairmanship of Dr. Meera Singh Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, RPCAU, Pusa with the sole objective to reorient graduates to promote employment opportunities, entrepreneurship skill development, confidence building and knowledge updating through practical work experience in real life situation. Altogether three hundred and eight (308) participants comprising 25 administrative staff members, 150 faculties, 98 students from 3 colleges (viz TCA Dholi, COF Dholi and PDUCH&F Piprakothi respectively) and 35 technical staff members were participated in the orientation workshop. ## Extension Activities

### ➤ **Kisan Gosthi cum Field Demonstration Organized**

ICAR-AICRP on FIM organized a Kisan Gosthi on the topic “**Use of hand operated Okra plucking hand tools**” at Tara Village, Kalyanpur. Seventy-five farmers participated in the Kisan Gosthi. FLD was also organized on Laser leveler and DSR technology in different villages of Samastipur district.



➤ **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Turki** organized World Environment Day on 05/06/2022 and International Yoga Day on 21.06.2022 at KVK campus. A total 54 participants participated in both events. Save tree and use of ecofriendly agriculture technology for crop production was highlights of the World Environment Day.

➤ **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sheohar** conducted field visit on June 9, 2022, where four scientists visited progressive women farmers' fields in the Sundarpur, Salempur, Kushahar, and Chamapur villages of Sheohar. ➤ **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Vaishali** organized "National Campaign under Aazadi ka amrit mahotsav” on the theme of International Yoga Day and Awareness on Balanced use of fertilizers on 21.06.2022. A total 55 farmers participated in this programme.

➤ **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Sheohar** conducted a FLD programme on "Distribution of Milky Mushroom Spawn among Women Farmers" in the Sundarpur and Salempur Villages of Sheohar on 23-06-2022. Twenty-five farmers took part in this programme and received the materials for mushroom cultivation, including milky mushroom spawn, a polythene bag, a rubber band, formalin and bavistin chemical.



- **Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Narkatiaganj** celebrated "World Milk Day" by organizing kishan-gosthi on the theme "Dairy Net Zero". A total of 45 farmers were made aware of proper management of dairy waste and their application on agricultural fields by the scientist and SMS of the KVK.

### Awards, Sports & Other activities

- **"Sukhet Model" bagged second prize by IUINDRR-NIDM** (India Universities and Institutions Network for Disaster Risk Reduction-National Institute of Disaster Management). An innovative platform was created by IUINDRR-NIDM for assessing the good practices of universities and institutions in the field regarding the role of women in disaster risk reduction. Entries were invited from all over India under the compendium on Agenda 3 of Honourable Prime Minister's 10 points on Disaster Risk Reduction, "Role of Women in Disaster Risk Management".
